Why do we deliver this?

In this composite, we will encourage students' curiosity for language learning and the festivals of the Spanish speaking world, as we study Día de los Muertos and Navidad.

Children will develop a core understanding of how Spanish language and grammar works. Children will manipulate comparative and superlative structures, in the present tense with increasing success.

This composite will form the building stones for the rest of their Spanish studies, through the use of high frequency vocabulary such as key conjunctions and key verbs such as Ser, Tener and Estar.

Children will practise their speaking skills, using Spanish phonics to improve their intonation and fluency.

Why do we deliver this?

In this composite, children will encounter a range of opinion verbs, enabling them to extend their sentences by giving and justifying their points of view. This composite will allow children to grow more confident in expressing themselves, develop as linguists.

In this composite, children will build on their grammatical knowledge, and the introduction of conditional tense verb formations will support them to **achieve** greater complexity and accuracy in their language use.

Reading aloud will be introduced to increase confidence, strengthen pronunciation, and help learners **thrive** in their spoken Spanish.

Why do we deliver this?

By the end of this composite, children will confidently draw on their prior knowledge of verb conjugations to manipulate verbs across three time frames—imperfect, present and conditional—while also using comparative and superlative structures with increasing success.

Speaking will form an essential part of this composite, giving children the opportunity to **achieve** fluency and apply their skills in real-life contexts, such as learning how to shop for clothes in Spanish.

Through these experiences, learners will continue to **thrive**, building the confidence, accuracy and independence needed for successful language learning.
